Welcome to year 2!

Welcome from your class teacher, Mr Devanney and your teaching assistant, Miss Sait. We are so excited to welcome the children back to CVPS and we can't wait to watch them progress in Year 2. Our class name is Emmeline Pankhurst. Over the term we will learn more about Emmeline and why she is an important figure in history.

Our topic for this term is 'Adventures in the City.' We will be learning about the history of our city. This will include when Bradford became a city, what it looks like on a map, and how it has changed over the last 100 years. Also, we focus on some important individuals and their lives in the history of Clayton and the city of Bradford. One person we focus on during our art topic is David Hockney and how his art styles have had an influence on the city. Water Bottles

Please ensure your child has a named water bottle that is filled with water every morning. Your child will be able to access their drink at multiple times throughout the day. Reading

Children should read at home at least 3 times a week. Please log each time your child reads on Boom reader. If you lose your login, please speak to the class teacher who can provide your child's details. Your child will bring their new reading book home on a Friday and must return it to school the next Tuesday.

If you lose your Go read login, please speak to the class teacher who will be able to provide your child's details.

Book Bags and Personal Belongings

Children can bring a bag to school to bring home letters, uniform and other important pieces of information. We ask that all personal belongings remain at home. Children do not need to bring any equipment from home. However, they must bring their bag with them every Tuesday and Friday to have their book changed.

PE

Year 2 will be doing PE on Tuesday afternoons. Your child should come to school in their PE kit on this day to avoid getting changed at school. They will need the correct coloured house T-shirt and black shorts. As we will be aiming to do PE lessons outside, your child can also wear a plain black hoody, black track suit bottoms and trainers. Children will not leave their PE kit at school.
