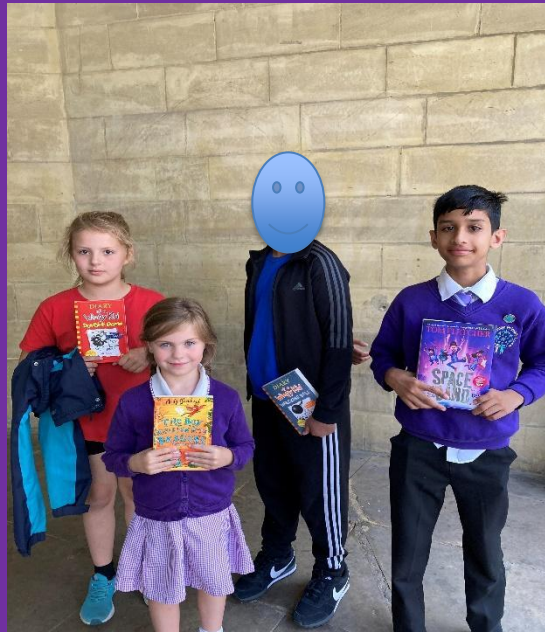
#### Amazon Wishlists

### Important Information

At the start of the next academic year some of our classes have moved around to different rooms in the school. This will have an impact on where children are dropped off to school and are collected. Please read below.

Reception have now moved to the old Year 2 classroom. The children will be dropped off and collected around the back of the school at the 'Swamp' entrance.

Year 1 are still in the same room. The children will be dropped off and collected around the back of the school at the old reception class door.

Year 2 have moved to the old Year 6 classroom. The children will be dropped off and collected around the back of the school next to the swamp entrance.

Year 3 and Year 4 will enter school through the Year 3/4 door and will be collected from the playground.

Year 5 and Year 6 will enter school through the year 5/6 door and will exit from the Year 5/6 door.

We will ensure any new entrances are sign posted clearly. If you cannot find the entrance please ask.
