IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Attendance

In line with DFE guidance, School attendance is mandatory for all pupils of compulsory school age and it is priority to ensure that as many children as possible regularly attend school. This means from that point, the usual rules on attendance will apply. Please refer to our attendance policy which is published on the school website. We always ask for your full support to ensure your child achieves their target of 96% or above by attending school every day. If for any reason your child is going to be absent, please contact the school office that day.
