#### Ping/Arbor transition -

As you are now aware, we have moved our messaging system from Ping over to Arbor. We can see that a lot of parents have signed into Arbor to activate their accounts, please can all parents/carers do this ASAP.

#### **Universal Free School Meals**

As most of you will know children from reception up to the end of Year 2 receive universal free school meals. Once your child moves into KS2 which starts in Year 3 they will be no longer entitled to a free school meal unless you qualify for them. Please check the link below to see if you would be entitled. Especially those who have moved up to Year 3 in September.

#### **Attendance**



We are noticing an increase in term time requests for holidays. While we understand that this is a time to spend with family and supports well-being as a Trust school, we follow the Trust Attendance Policy. This means the majority of term time holidays are unauthorised and can result in fines.

Please see an extract from the policy below.

#### 5.1 Approval for term-time absence

The headteacher will allow pupils to be absent from the school site for certain educational activities, or to attend other schools or settings.

The headteacher will only grant a leave of absence to a pupil during term time if the request meets the specific circumstances set out in the 2024 school attendance regulations. These circumstances are:

- Taking part in a regulated performance, or regulated employment abroad
- Attending an interview
- Study leave
- A temporary, time-limited part-time timetable
- Exceptional circumstances

A leave of absence is granted at the headteacher's discretion, including the length of time the pupil is authorised to be absent for.

Leave of absence will not be granted for a pupil to take part in protest activity during school hours.

PLEASE NOTE: holidays are not deemed exceptional circumstances and will not be authorised.

The school considers each application for term-time absence individually, taking into account the specific facts, circumstances and relevant background context behind the request. Any request should be submitted as soon as it is anticipated and, where possible, at least two weeks before the absence, and in accordance with any leave of absence request form, accessible via the school office. The headteacher may require evidence to support any request for leave of absence.
